Dear brother Belden

I have a note from Dr Barton in which he says

Dr. Ward of the Independent wrote me three days ago asking for the MS. to cut up and use as Articles in the Independent and I sent it to him. but I have another copy - first draft. which with a few hours work I could make ready for another printer.

but it will be a few days before I can get the leisure to do prepare it.

Meanwhile would you kindly tell me in what form, or size you propose to print it; ~~in~~ how many copies you propose to print, and what you expect to pay for the job?

Also have you made a positive contract for the job? so that you must furnish the work to that press?

I am having a good deal of printing done at a good press near me here, at which I have special rates. I have asked Dr. Ward to return  
the best MS. after using it &  
that would save my having  
to work up the other.
